AMENDING SECTIONS 1-215 AND 40-201, ARIZONA REVISED STATUTES; RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY.

1 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Arizona: Section 1. Section 1-215, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to 2 3 read: 4 1-215. Definitions 5 In the statutes and laws of this state, unless the context otherwise 6 requires: 7 1. "Action" includes any matter or proceeding in a court, civil or 8 criminal. 9 2. "Adopted rule" means a final rule as defined in section 41-1001. 3. "Adult" means a person who has attained eighteen years of age. 10 11 4. "Alternative fuel" means: 12 (a) Electricity. 13 (b) Solar energy. 14 (c) Liquefied petroleum gas, natural gas, hydrogen or a blend of 15 hydrogen with liquefied petroleum or natural gas that complies with any of 16 the following: 17 (i) Is used in an engine that is certified to meet at a minimum the 18 United States environmental protection agency low emission vehicle standard 19 pursuant to 40 Code of Federal Regulations section 88.104-94 or 88.105-94. 20 (ii) Is used in an engine that is certified by the engine modifier to 21 meet the addendum to memorandum 1-A of the United States environmental 22 protection agency as printed in the federal register, volume 62, number 207, 23 October 27, 1997, pages 55635 through 55637. 24 (iii) Is used in an engine that is the subject of a waiver for that 25 specific engine application from the United States environmental protection agency's memorandum 1-A addendum requirements and that waiver is documented 26 27 to the reasonable satisfaction of the director of the department of 28 environmental quality. 29 (d) Only for vehicles that use alcohol fuels before August 21, 1998, 30 alcohol fuels that contain not less than eighty-five per cent PERCENT alcohol 31 by volume. 32 (e) A combination of at least seventy per cent PERCENT alternative 33 fuel and no more than thirty per cent PERCENT petroleum based fuel that 34 operates in an engine that meets the United States environmental protection 35 agency low emission vehicle standard pursuant to 40 Code of Federal Regulations section 88.104-94 or 88.105-94 and that is certified by the 36 37 engine manufacturer to consume at least seventy per cent PERCENT alternative 38 fuel during normal vehicle operations. 39 5. "Bribe" means anything of value or advantage, present or 40 prospective, asked, offered, given, accepted or promised with a corrupt 41 intent to influence, unlawfully, the person to whom it is given in that 42 person's action, vote or opinion, in any public or official capacity. 43 6. "Child" or "children" as used in reference to age of persons means 44 persons under eighteen years of age.

7. "Clean burning fuel" means:

(a) An emulsion of water-phased hydrocarbon fuel that contains not 2 3 less than twenty per cent PERCENT water by volume and that complies with any 4 of the following:

(i) Is used in an engine that is certified to meet at a minimum the United States environmental protection agency low emission vehicle standard 6 7 pursuant to 40 Code of Federal Regulations section 88.104-94 or 88.105-94.

8 (ii) Is used in an engine that is certified by the engine modifier to 9 meet the addendum to memorandum 1-A of the United States environmental protection agency as printed in the federal register, volume 62, number 207, 10 11 October 27, 1997, pages 55635 through 55637.

12 (iii) Is used in an engine that is the subject of a waiver for that 13 specific engine application from the United States environmental protection 14 agency's memorandum 1-A addendum requirements and that waiver is documented 15 to the reasonable satisfaction of the director of the department of 16 environmental quality.

17 (b) A diesel fuel substitute that is produced from nonpetroleum renewable resources if the qualifying volume of the nonpetroleum renewable 18 19 resources meets the standards for California diesel fuel as adopted by the 20 California air resources board pursuant to 13 California Code of Regulations 21 sections 2281 and 2282 in effect on January 1, 2000, the diesel fuel 22 substitute meets the registration requirement for fuels and additives 23 established by the United States environmental protection agency pursuant to 24 section 211 of the clean air act as defined in section 49-401.01 and the use 25 of the diesel fuel substitute complies with the requirements listed in 10 26 Code of Federal Regulations part 490, as printed in the federal register, 27 volume 64, number 96, May 19, 1999.

(c) A diesel fuel that complies with all of the following:

29 (i) Contains a maximum of fifteen parts per million by weight of 30 sulfur.

(ii) Meets ASTM D975.

32 (iii) Meets the registration requirements for fuels and additives 33 established by the United States environmental protection agency pursuant to 34 section 211 of the clean air act as defined in section 49-401.01.

35 (iv) Is used in an engine that is equipped or has been retrofitted 36 with a device that has been certified by the California air resources board diesel emission control strategy verification procedure, the United States 37 environmental protection agency voluntary diesel retrofit program or the 38 39 United States environmental protection agency verification protocol for 40 retrofit catalyst, particulate filter and engine modification control 41 technologies for highway and nonroad use diesel engines.

42 (d) A blend of unleaded gasoline that contains at minimum eighty-five 43 per cent PERCENT ethanol by volume or eighty-five per cent PERCENT methanol 44 by volume.

1 (e) Neat methanol. 2 (f) Neat ethanol. 3 8. "Corruptly" means a wrongful design to acquire or cause some 4 pecuniary or other advantage to the person guilty of the act or omission 5 referred to, or to some other person. "Daytime" means the period between sunrise and sunset. 6 9. 7 10. "Depose" includes every manner of written statement under oath or 8 affirmation. 9 11. "Federal poverty guidelines" means the poverty guidelines as 10 updated annually in the federal register by the United States department of 11 health and human services. 12 "Grantee" includes every person to whom an estate or interest in 12. 13 real property passes, in or by a deed. 14 13. "Grantor" includes every person from or by whom an estate or 15 interest in real property passes, in or by a deed. 14. "Includes" or "including" means not limited to and is not a term of 16 17 exclusion. 18 15. "Inhabitant" means a resident of a city, town, village, district, 19 county or precinct. 20 16. "Issue" as used in connection with descent of estates includes all 21 lawful. lineal descendants of the ancestor. 22 17. "Knowingly": 23 (a) MEANS only a knowledge that the facts exist that bring the act or 24 omission within the provisions of the statute using such word. 25 (b) Does not require any knowledge of the unlawfulness of the act or 26 omission. 27 18. "Magistrate" means an officer having power to issue a warrant for 28 the arrest of a person charged with a public offense and includes the chief 29 justice and justices of the supreme court, judges of the superior court, 30 justices of the peace and police magistrates in cities and towns. 31 19. "Majority" or "age of majority" as used in reference to age of 32 persons means the age of eighteen years or more OF AGE. 33 20. "Malice" and "maliciously" mean a wish to vex, annoy or injure 34 another person, or an intent to do a wrongful act, established either by 35 proof or presumption of law. "Minor" means a person under the age of eighteen years. 36 21. 37 "Minor children" means persons under the age of eighteen years. 22. "Month" means a calendar month unless otherwise expressed. 38 23. "Neglect", "negligence", "negligent" and "negligently" import a 39 24. 40 want of such attention to the nature or probable consequence of the act or 41 omission as a prudent man ordinarily bestows in acting in his own concerns. 42 "Nighttime" means the period between sunset and sunrise. 25. 43 26. "Oath" includes an affirmation or declaration. 44 27. "Peace officers" means sheriffs of counties, constables, marshals, 45 policemen of cities and towns, commissioned personnel of the department of

1 public safety, personnel who are employed by the state department of 2 corrections and the department of juvenile corrections and who have received 3 a certificate from the Arizona peace officer standards and training board, 4 peace officers who are appointed by a multicounty water conservation district 5 and who have received a certificate from the Arizona peace officer standards and training board, police officers who are appointed by community college 6 7 district governing boards and who have received a certificate from the 8 Arizona peace officer standards and training board, police officers who are 9 appointed by the Arizona board of regents and who have received a certificate from the Arizona peace officer standards and training board, police officers 10 11 who are appointed by the governing body of a public airport pursuant to 12 section 28-8426 and who have received a certificate from the Arizona peace 13 officer standards and training board and special agents from the office of 14 the attorney general, or of a county attorney, and who have received a 15 certificate from the Arizona peace officer standards and training board.

"Person" includes a corporation, company, partnership, firm, 16 28. 17 association or society, as well as a natural person. When the word "person" 18 is used to designate the party whose property may be the subject of a 19 criminal or public offense, the term includes the United States, this state, 20 or any territory, state or country, or any political subdivision of this 21 state that may lawfully own any property, or a public or private corporation, 22 or partnership or association. When the word "person" is used to designate 23 the violator or offender of any law, it includes corporation, partnership or 24 any association of persons.

25 29. "Personal property" includes money, goods, chattels, dogs, things
26 in action and evidences of debt.

30. "Population" means the population according to the most recentUnited States decennial census.

29 31. "Process" means a citation, writ or summons issued in the course of 30 judicial proceedings.

32. "Property" includes both real and personal property.

32 33. "Real property" is coextensive with lands, tenements and 33 hereditaments.

34. "Registered mail" includes certified mail.

35. "RENEWABLE ENERGY" INCLUDES SOLAR, WIND, HYDROELECTRIC, PUMPED 36 STORAGE, FLYWHEEL STORAGE, HYDROGEN, GEOTHERMAL, BIOMASS AND BIOMASS BASELOAD 37 ENERGY AND NUCLEAR ENERGY FROM SOURCES THAT ARE FUELED BY URANIUM FUEL RODS 38 THAT INCLUDE EIGHTY PERCENT OR MORE OF RECYCLED NUCLEAR FUEL AND NATURAL 39 THORIUM REACTOR RESOURCES UNDER DEVELOPMENT.

40 35. 36. "Seal" as used in reference to a paper issuing from a court or 41 public office to which the seal of such court or office is required to be 42 affixed means an impression of the seal on that paper, an impression of the 43 seal affixed to that paper by a wafer or wax, a stamped seal, a printed seal, 44 a screened seal or a computer generated seal.

1 36. 37. "Signature" or "subscription" includes a mark, if a person 2 cannot write, with the person's name written near it and witnessed by a 3 person who writes the person's own name as witness. 37. 38. "State", as applied to the different parts of the United 4 5 States, includes the District of Columbia, this state and the territories. 6 38. 39. "Testify" includes every manner of oral statement under oath 7 or affirmation. 8 39. 40. "United States" includes the District of Columbia and the 9 territories. 40. 41. "Vessel", as used in reference to shipping, includes ships of 10 11 all kinds, steamboats, steamships, barges, canal boats and every structure 12 adapted to navigation from place to place for the transportation of persons 13 or property. 14 41. 42. "Wilfully" means, with respect to conduct or to a circumstance 15 described by a statute defining an offense, that a person is aware or 16 believes that the person's conduct is of that nature or that the circumstance 17 exists. 18 "Will" includes codicils. 42. 43. 19 43. 44. "Workers' compensation" means workmen's compensation as used 20 in article XVIII, section 8, Constitution of Arizona. 21 44. 45. "Writ" means an order or precept in writing issued in the name 22 of the state or by a court or judicial officer. 23 45. 46. "Writing" includes printing. 24 Sec. 2. Section 40-201, Arizona Revised Statutes, is amended to read: 25 40-201. Definitions In this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires: 26 Α. 27 1. "Ancillary services" means those services designated as ancillary 28 services in federal energy regulatory commission order 888 adopted in 1996 29 including the services necessary to support the transmission of electricity 30 from resources to loads while maintaining reliable operation of the 31 transmission system in accordance with good utility practice. 32 2. "Appliance application" means central space heating, clothes 33 drying, water heating and indoor cooking. 34 3. "Bundled service" means electric service provided as a package to 35 the consumer including all generation, transmission, distribution, ancillary 36 and other services necessary to deliver and measure useful electricity used 37 by consumers. "Commission" means the Arizona corporation commission. 38 4. 39 "Common carrier" means a railroad or street railroad. 5. 40 "Electric distribution facilities" means all property used in 6. 41 connection with the distribution of electricity from an electric generating 42 plant to retail electric customers except electric transmission facilities. 43 7. "Electric distribution service" means the distribution of 44 electricity to retail electric customers through the use of electric 45 distribution facilities.

1 8. "Electric distribution utility" means a public service corporation 2 or public power entity that operates, controls or maintains electric 3 distribution facilities.

9. "Electric generation plant" means all property used in connection with the generation for sale of electricity to retail electric customers but excluding any services provided by electric transmission facilities or electric distribution facilities.

8 10. "Electric generation service" means the provision of electricity 9 for sale to retail electric customers but does not include electric 10 distribution or transmission services and generation that are necessary for 11 the reliable operation of the electric distribution or transmission system.

12 11. "Electric transmission facilities" means all property so classified
13 by the federal energy regulatory commission or, to the extent permitted by
14 law, so classified by the Arizona corporation commission.

15 12. "Electric transmission service" means the transmission of 16 electricity to retail electric customers or to electric distribution 17 facilities that is so classified by the federal energy regulatory commission 18 or, to the extent permitted by law, so classified by the Arizona corporation 19 commission.

13. "Electricity" means electric energy, electric capacity or electric
capacity and energy.

14. "Electricity supplier" means a person, whether acting in a principal, agent or other capacity, that is a public service corporation that offers to sell electricity to a retail electric customer in this state.

25 15. "Foreign nonprofit, member owned cooperative corporation" means a 26 cooperative incorporated in another state if that state has not ordered 27 electric competition for cooperative corporations.

28 16. "Gas plant" includes all property used in connection with the 29 production, transmission or delivery of gas for light, heat or power for 30 sale.

31 17. "Other services" means metering, meter reading, billing and 32 collecting services.

33 18. "Pipeline" includes all property used in transmission for 34 compensation of air, steam or fluid substances, except water, through 35 pipelines.

36 19. "Railroad" includes every railway, other than a street railroad,
 37 operated for public transportation of persons or property.

20. "Residential structure" means a detached owner-occupied or rental one or two family dwelling unit, an attached duplex or fourplex unit, a manufactured home, a residential factory-built building as defined in section 41-2142, paragraph 14 or a mobile home designed to be used with a permanent structure, excluding real property used to accommodate more than four attached dwelling units. 1 21. "Retail electric customer" means a person who purchases electricity 2 for that person's own use, including use in that person's trade or business, 3 and not for resale, redistribution or retransmission.

22. "Service territory" means the geographic area in which a public 4 5 power entity or public service corporation owns, operates, controls or maintains electric distribution facilities or natural gas distribution 6 7 facilities and that additional area in which the public power entity or 8 public service corporation has agreed to extend electric distribution 9 facilities or natural gas distribution facilities, whether established by a certificate of convenience and necessity, by official action by a public 10 11 power entity or by contract or agreement.

12 23. "Sewer corporation" includes every person owning, controlling,13 operating or managing any sewage system for profit.

14 24. "Sewerage system" includes all property used in connection with the 15 collection, treatment, purification and disposal transmission, storage or 16 treatment of sewage.

17 25. "Street railroad" includes every railway operated along any street 18 or public way for public transportation of persons or property, but does not 19 include a commercial or interurban railway.

20 26. "Telecommunications corporation" means a public service corporation 21 other than municipal engaged in transmitting messages or furnishing public 22 telegraph or telephone service or operating as a telecommunications common 23 carrier.

24 27. "Telegraph line" includes all property used in connection with 25 communication by telegraph for compensation with or without the use of 26 transmission wires.

27 28. "Telephone line" includes all property used in connection with 28 communication by telephone, for compensation, with or without the use of 29 transmission wires.

30 29. "Transportation of persons" includes every service in connection 31 with the carriage and delivery of a person and the person's baggage.

32 30. "Transportation of property" includes every service in connection 33 with the transportation and handling of property.

34 31. "Water system" includes all property used in connection with the 35 diversion, development, storage, distribution and sale of water for 36 beneficial uses for compensation.

B. IN THIS CHAPTER, AND IN RULES AND ORDERS ADOPTED AND ISSUED
PURSUANT TO THIS CHAPTER, "RENEWABLE ENERGY" INCLUDES THE USE OF
HYDROELECTRIC, PUMPED STORAGE, FLYWHEEL STORAGE, HYDROGEN, GEOTHERMAL,
BIOMASS AND BIOMASS BASELOAD POWER AND NUCLEAR ENERGY SOURCES THAT ARE FUELED
BY URANIUM FUEL RODS THAT INCLUDE EIGHTY PERCENT OR MORE OF RECYCLED NUCLEAR
FUEL AND NATURAL THORIUM REACTOR RESOURCES UNDER DEVELOPMENT IN THE
PRODUCTION OF ELECTRICITY.
